COUNSELOR:
Requires staff training and overnight availability. Counselors will work along with a Republic Leader to oversee Republic of up to 12 campers. Counselors may also assist with specialities and electives.

SUPPORT STAFF:
Requires staff training and overnight availability. Support Staff's primary role is to serve as kitchen staff and help behind the scenes in various ways. Support Staff will be assigned to a Republic of up to 12 campers and help Republic Leader and Counselor and assist with free-time activities and specialty classes as needed.

WORK CREW:
Requires staff training and overnight availability. Responsibilities include camp property maintenance, restock facilities, set up and tear down for all games and activities, as well as assist in free-time activities and specialty classes as needed.

INSTRUCTOR:
Instruct a specialty and/or elective (minimum of 2-5 hours/day). Day or overnight availability. See below for possible classes.

The following are a list of items each person needs to bring to camp. If you need assistance supplying any of these items, please contact Barefoot Republic Camp Office. **PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING WITH YOUR NAME OR INITIALS.**

Required Items:

- 6-10 t-shirts
- 6 pairs of shorts
- 6 pairs of socks
- 6 pairs of underwear
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, soap, deodorant, baby oil/lotion, etc.)
- 1 pair of comfortable tennis shoes
- 1 pair of old shoes for messy games
- 2 towels
- Bedding for single twin bed (pillow, sheets, blanket and/or sleeping bag)
- Jacket or sweatshirt
- 2 pair of long pants or jeans
- Sun screen and bug repellent
- 1-2 outfits that can get messy
- 1-piece bathing suit
- Water bottle

Optional Items to Bring:

- Bible (if you don't have one, we can supply one for you to use)
- 2 pens or pencils
- Shower shoes
- Shower cap (for messy games)
- Goggles
- Water shoes (for creek/lake)
- Cleats (for soccer and/or football)

Do NOT Bring the Following:

- Candy or drinks

If the following items are brought to camp, you will be immediately sent home:
